She is the owner of Miss Hattie's Restaurant & Saloon, located in the heart of historic downtown San Angelo.

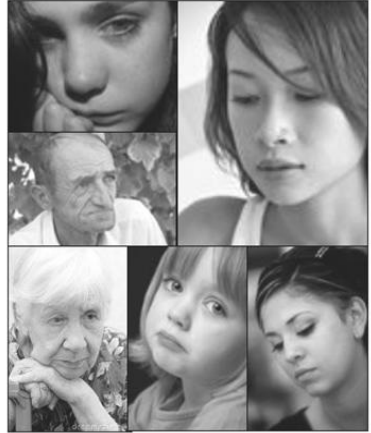
Brenda is the current President of Downtown San Angelo and Chair of the Design and Promotions Committees of Downtown San Angelo.



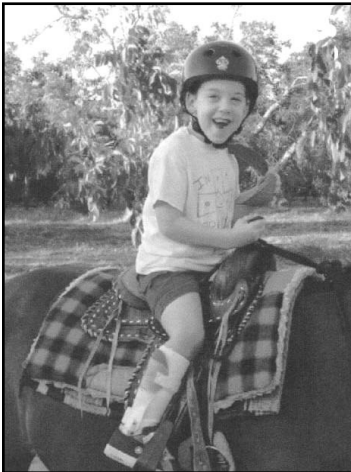

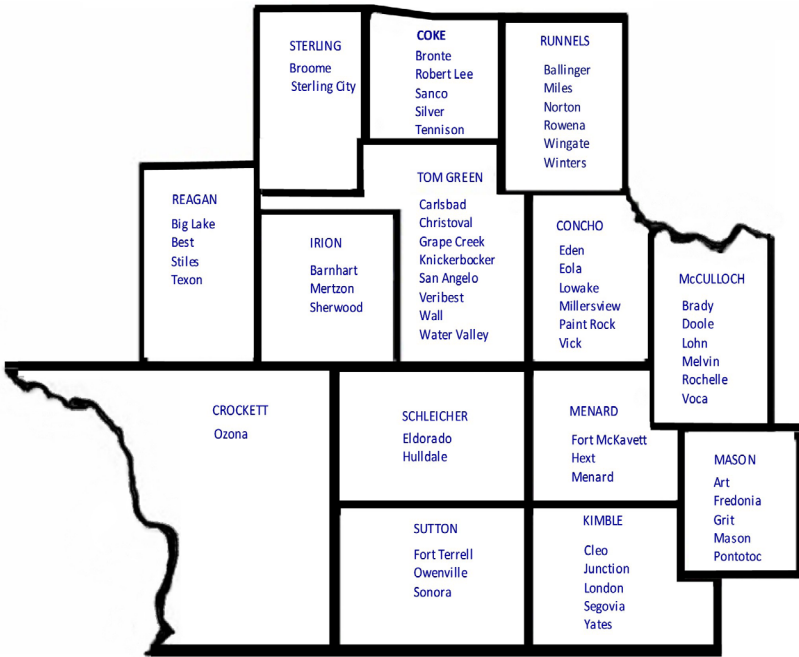
